1. Purpose

2. Our Commitments

Musicrange is committed to:

- Comply with all relevant environmental legislation and regulations.
- Actively seek to reduce waste and promote recycling in our operations.
- Reduce energy and water consumption wherever possible.
- Encourage sustainable travel practices among staff, volunteers, and participants.
- Source materials and services from environmentally responsible suppliers where feasible.

3. Areas of Focus

- Energy and Water:
 - Minimise energy use by turning off equipment when not in use.
 - Encourage the use of energy-efficient equipment.
 - Minimise water waste.
- Waste and Recycling:
 - Reduce the amount of waste generated.
 - Reuse materials where possible.
 - Recycle paper, plastics, and other materials wherever facilities exist.
- Travel:
 - Encourage the use of public transport, car-sharing, cycling, or walking for work-related travel.
 - Promote virtual meetings where possible to reduce the need for travel.
- Sustainable Procurement:
 - Consider the environmental impact of goods and services before purchasing.
 - Prefer suppliers with strong environmental credentials and practices.

- Events and Programmes:
 - Design and deliver events and programmes with sustainability in mind.
 - Minimise single-use plastics and promote environmentally friendly practices at all Musicrange activities.
